Manitoba Pork Marketing's forward contract prices opened mixed this morning. US cash markets are responding positively to the gains in the pork cut seen earlier this week. Packers increased their bids by more than a \$1.00/cwt yesterday and today's trade is also looking at gains. However, wholesale pork prices are seeing a pull back with all of the primal cuts seeing weakness yesterday. Packers are planning for a large Saturday kill, estimated at about 160,000 hogs, comparable with levels seen in recent weeks. Lean Hog futures saw weakness yesterday; with all taking back contracts some of the early week gains. Currently, winter forward contract prices are trading near their highest level in more than a month, about \$10.00/ckg better than prices seen two weeks ago.

Canadian delivered soymeal prices opened lower this morning. Soymeal futures traded moderately lower yesterday and into the overnight mostly due to major weather forecasting models pushing the frost line for next week's cold weather over the Canadian border. A change in the basis for old crop soymeal has brought the cash price down almost \$30/MT this morning.

Canadian delivered corn prices opened lower this morning. Corn saw steep losses yesterday, which continued into the overnight session, as selling accelerated with news of an improved frost forecast. The Canadian Dollar is trading above \$0.94US at open, helping to further amplify losses and lower the cash price.
