

Forward contract prices opened lower this morning. US cash markets are called lower to start the week, as packer margins are forcing them to aim at a smaller weekly slaughter of 1.99 million hogs. Last week, packers were unable to reach their goal and killed 1.992 million hogs, despite the lure of significantly higher bids early in the week. Wholesale pork prices are maintaining good support, as pork supplies continue to tighten, while consumers are buying more fresh pork for grilling. Lean Hog futures are expected to trade near steady this morning as traders are hesitant to put any premium on the summer month contracts while cash prices come under pressure. The Canadian Dollar is trading in huge volatility with this morning's trade gaining more than a cent and a half over last week's close.

Canadian delivered soymeal prices opened higher this morning. Soybean futures are higher this morning, bouncing back from four-week lows. Lack of producer selling together with strong export demand are the main factors influencing this bullish trend.

Canadian delivered corn prices opened steady this morning. Corn markets opened steady this morning with gains being capped by a decrease in crude oil prices. As well, forecasts for unfavorable weather for the week together with strong demand have limited downside movement.
