Forward contract prices opened mixed this morning. U.S. cash markets are firing on all cylinders, with both wholesale pork markets and packer bids making gains to start this week. Normal seasonality would have most of the primal cuts coming under heavy selling pressure, typically resulting a $10 \%-20 \%$ decline from summer highs. This year, export markets have supported the pork carcass cut-out which has moved higher while slaughter levels have grown close to the highest levels seen this year. Lean Hog futures continue to suggest further strength in the next two weeks, but a slump in prices coming before mid -December. The Canadian Dollar continues to provide new opportunities to hedge with the loonie dropping to under US\$0.95 this morning. Producers looking to add price protection should continue using target pricing, adding small increments of protection on increases of \$5.00/ckg.
