Forward contract prices opened mixed this morning. Packer bids are trending lower as live hog supplies are outpacing the demand, while wholesale pork prices have come under pressure lately, a typical trend for this time of year. Weekly hog slaughter has consistently outpaced last year's by about 2% for the last month and a half, which until recently, was easily cleared from the market via increased export sales. Lean Hog futures have come under pressure from technical selling, with fund managers attempting to preserve the gains achieved in their portfolio by selling out of their large long positions. The Canadian Dollar continues to trade with high volatility as the Loonie weakens compared to the U.S. Dollar after yesterday's trade which saw the biggest one day gains in months. Winter month forward contract prices reflect good value given the uncertain in both exchange rates and export sales for pork.

Canadian delivered soymeal prices opened higher this USDA reported lower than expected yields therefore less production. This however was offset by the lowered expected exports by 40 million bushels. Average yield was predicted to be 41.8 bushels per acre last month and is now 41.5 bushels per acre.

Canadian delivered corn prices opened higher this morning. The USDA noted a sale of 900,000 metric tons to China for 2011/12 and 292.110 metric tons to unknown destinations. Yield expectations remain constant at 148.1 bushels per acre.
