Forward contract prices opened higher this morning. U.S. cash prices continue on their weaker trend with packers having no trouble meeting production requirements over the next several weeks. Average carcass weights however, in the lowa/S. Minnesota region are down about one pound from 276 lbs last week, indicating that producers have been preparing for the reduced holiday schedule. Lean Hog futures are focused largely on tomorrow's release of the Hogs and Pigs report which is expected to show market hog numbers up about 1.3% vs year ago. The table to the right covers the major categories and is the average of industry estimates as compiled by Dow Jones Newswire. Increasingly, traders are becoming optimistic about the Canada's economy in 2012, resulting in support to the Loonie.
