Forward contract prices opened lower this morning. U.S. cash markets opened lower, with an abundant supply of hogs ready for the first full day of slaughter in 3 days. Hog supply is likely to outpace demand for the next two weeks, strictly as a result of the limitation of production days. Wholesale pork prices are expected to make improvements over the same timeframe as supply is constrained and demand remains firm. Lean Hog futures are starting this week lower as traders will factor in some of the cash market weakness to the nearby contracts. 2012 contracts have been on a bearish trend for several weeks, caused by the belief that export orders to China have dried up, resulting in volumes more comparable to year ago levels. The Canadian Dollar is starting this week higher, following the stock market as traders' perspectives on the U.S. economy improves.
