Forward contract prices opened lower this morning. U.S. cash markets are expected to trade steady to lower this week, as packers are cutting production, but not as fast as hog supply is shrinking. Packer bids declined sharply on Friday, with most reporting regions dropping close to \$4.00/ cwt. In spite of this, packers continue to lose money on meat sales as the pork cut-out is lower than what they are paying for live hogs. Nearby Lean Hog futures are in a sideways trend, staying within a \$3.00/cwt trading range over the last 2 months. Summer month contracts have found more support and have resulted in forward contract prices that exceed the cash prices that were seen last summer. The Canadian Dollar is down close to 50 basis points with concerns over Greece's debt contributing to strong demand for the U.S. Dollar.
