Forward contract prices opened mixed this morning. U.S. cash markets broke under the significant pressure of poor profitability vesterday, with 3 of the 4 major reporting regions dropping under the \$80/cwt mark. Packers that have benefitted from strong export sales recently could no longer rationalize the prices that they were paying. Tightening supplies over the month of April will likely stem the bearish trend that the cash market has experienced. Lean Hog futures also reacted negatively to the cash market's move, with traders growing concerned that the typical seasonal rally into the summer months was not going to materialize. Among a number of USDA report releases today, the Hogs and Pigs report will be released at 2 pm. Average estimates compared to year ago numbers for the major categories are as follows: Market hogs - 101.8%, Breeding herd - 100.3%, Pig Crop -102.4%.

Canadian delivered soymeal prices opened higher this **morning.** Soybean prospective plantings are down one percent from last year with 2012 estimates at 73.9 million acres. Soy stored in all positions as of March 1 is 1.37 billion bushels. Stored soy on and off farms have increased 10 percent from a year ago. The disappearance for Dec 2011-Feb 2012 was 998 million bushels; this has decreased by 3 percent from this same quarter a year prior.

Canadian delivered corn prices opened higher this morn-

ing. Corn prospective plantings are up four percent from last year with 2012 intentions to plant 95.9 million acres. All stored corn as of March 1 is 6.01 billion bushels, down 8 percent from that time last year. Disappearance for the Dec 2011-Feb 2012 quarter is the similar to last year for the same period at 3.64 billion bushels.
