Forward contract prices opened lower this morning.

US cash markets started the week higher, with packers competing for limited uncommitted supplies. However, the increases in cash bids is only resulting in deeper losses for most plants as wholesale pork prices have failed to sustain any gains over the last month. Yesterday, the pork cut-out as reported on the USDA's voluntary report was down \$1.62/cwt. All cuts moved lower from the previous day and are trading at their lowest levels in several weeks. There is uncertainty in the demand for pork and futures traders are factoring this in across all months. The bullish trend that was clearly established early last week, has been replaced by a sharply lower trend which is testing support levels that were established 6 months ago. While trading about one cent higher than levels seen 10 days ago, the Canadian Dollar is still relatively good value when you compare it with the trading range of the last 3 months.

Canadian delivered soymeal prices opened higher this morning. US soybean futures opened lower this morning. Yesterday, soybean futures were at their highest levels since mid-December and analysts are suggesting that shortterm profit taking is partly responsible for the drop in prices today. Argentine weather is day-to-day and production estimates are expected to be revised lower. However, Brazil's yields look positive and between 81.2 and 85 mmt are forecast; comparatively, the 2007-2011 5-year average was 67.06 mmt.

Canadian delivered corn prices opened lower this morning. US corn futures are trading lower this morning. The drop in corn is associated with profit taking ahead of the USDA's WASDE Report released this Friday. As well, modest rain showers are forecast for Argentina and positive crop assessments from Brazil are adding to a bearish tone. Lately, markets have been reacting to news from South America more so than domestic factors such as moisture levels in the US Corn Belt which will be crucial for longer term guidance.
