Forward contract prices opened lower this morning. US cash markets finished last week sharply lower as it appeared that packers had decided to take action against their negative operating margins and reduce their cash market bids. The estimated slaughter of last week was impacted by this decision, with numbers estimated at 2.139 million head, down nearly 40,000 hogs from the week previous. Packers are still estimated to be losing about \$6.00/hog, when using the value of the voluntary pork cut-out in the calculation. Pork prices have decreased by about 5% over the last week, possibly coinciding with a reduction in export demand as orders from China to meet New Year's demand would have diminished. Export sales in December were down 13.6% from year ago levels reflecting softer demand from this segment of the market. Currently, there is little support for spring and summer month contracts except for the fact that they have already fallen about 4% of their value in the last 2 weeks.

Canadian delivered soymeal prices opened lower this morning. US soybean futures opened lower this morning. Prices fell to their lowest levels since mid-January following the release of Friday's WASDE Report. Despite modest production uncertainty, an upward revision of global supplies was noted. Global demand this week is expected to remain relatively low due to holiday closures in China. A general consensus is that the market is heavily influenced by South American developments. However, analysts will need to focus on North American production estimates for longer term outlooks.

Canadian delivered corn prices opened lower this morning. US corn futures opened lower this morning. Grains markets are down in general following Friday's WASDE Report. The Report showed higher ending stocks than analysts' previous average estimates that were also higher than the USDA's January figures. Export demand was cut by 50 million bu. as Ukraine's and Brazil's corn appear to be favoured to the US variant. Ethanol demand remained unchanged 'adding' supply to the US carryout.
