Forward contract prices opened higher this morning. US packers increased their cash bids sharply yesterday as they had difficulty meeting production schedules, as reflected by USDA's reported daily slaughter of only 382,000 hogs. The lowa/S. Minnesota region reported close to a \$2.00/cwt increase as packers shared some of their positive operating margin to secure more supplies. Packers have been experiencing a tightening of supply, in line with the typical seasonal trend. Lean Hog futures are starting the last day of the week with higher prices as traders factor in the late-week gains experienced in the cash market. All of the 2014 Lean Hog futures contracts are trading at or near contract highs, reflecting the dominant bullish fundamentals of tight hog supplies, high prices of competing meats and improving export sales potential. Producers with less than 30% of their summer month production already covered should consider adding targets at \$5.00/ckg price increments in blocks of 10% of their production. In other news, Manitoba's Chief Veterinary Office reported that positive samples of PEDv were found from pigs on a wean to finish farm in Southeast Manitoba. The samples have been sent to the National Centre for Foreign Animal Disease for confirmation.

Canadian delivered soymeal prices opened even this morning.

US soybean futures are trading higher on sustained demand. It was expected that the market was poised to turn lower following Chinese cancellations that started with 272,000MT on Wednesday. However, even that number was lower than expected and new crop sales numbers have added support. Rain in Brazil is aiding crop development but hindering harvest and supporting the nearby contracts. The USDA's preliminary planting projection is for 78 million acres this year, lower than market expectations.

Canadian delivered corn prices opened even this morning. US corn futures are trading lower. The downside has been limited by strength in other agricultural commodities and a revision downward by the Argentina Grains Exchange to the Argentine crop by 500,000 lower than USDA estimates. However pressure comes from 8 straight weeks of Chinese cancellations (due to the GMO dispute) and a USDA projection that shows 2014/15 ending stocks to be 2.607 billion bu. (1.481 billion bu. currently); the US is estimated to plant 93.5 million acres.
